DERBY SPECIFICATIONS

1. No NJPHA membership required or derby class qualifying required.
2. Derby entry fees are \$75 per Derby.
3. The same horse may be used in both derbies, but must be ridden by different Fall Finale qualified riders.
4. Both Derbies will run under the Hunt N' Go Format.
5. Derby entry fees are non refundable.
6. Derbies will be open all day, riders will do their "derby" trip at the conclusion of the last over fence class in their 1st division, (if competing in more than 1 division)
7. Ribbons and awards from 1st place through 8th place.
8. \$1000 Payout as follows: 1st=310, 2nd=205, 3rd=100 4th=85, 5th=75, 6th=75, 7th=75, 8th=75

Derbies will be scored on soundness, performance, suitability, and rider's general ability and knowledge of navigating a "derby" course.

Hunt N' Go Derby Specifications

In the Hunt and Go Derby format, riders complete one Classic Hunter Round and one Handy Hunter Round consecutively, without a break, in a single course to achieve their final score. The first phase, the Classic Round, assesses fundamental hunter qualities, while the consecutive Handy Round rewards brilliance, pace, and handiness through features like tight turns, different tracks, and handy options. All competitors participate in both phases, and receive a score for each phase (classic round and handy round) and the combined score from both rounds determines their final ranking.

Format Breakdown

Consecutive Phases:

Unlike the traditional two-round derby, the Hunt and Go format merges the Classic and Handy sections into a single, flowing course.

Classic Round:

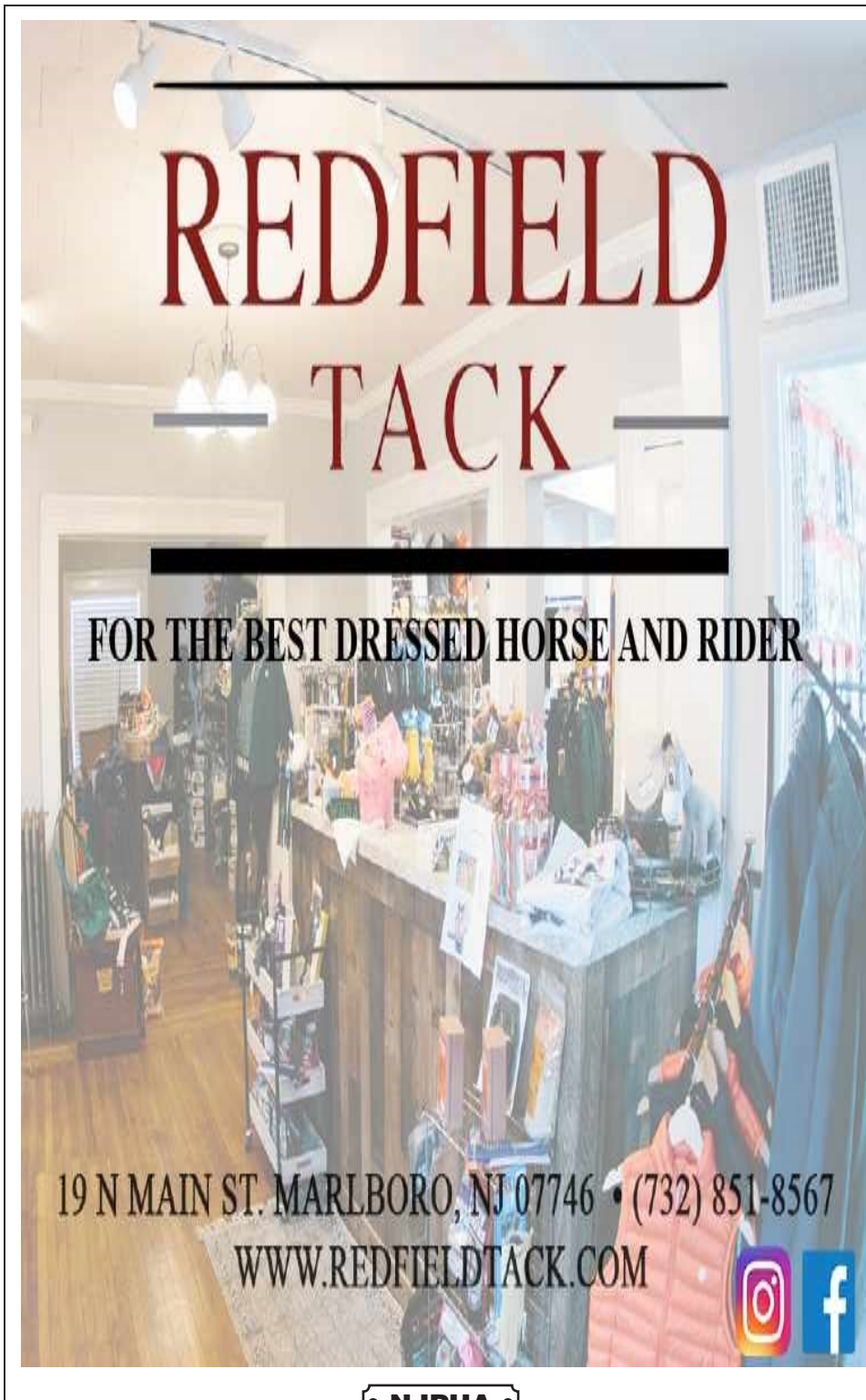
This initial phase focuses on judging the horse's (or pony's) performance, manners, movement, and overall way of going over a classic-style hunter course.

Handy Round:

Immediately following the Classic Round, the course transitions to a "Handy" style. This phase emphasizes a faster pace, handiness, and the ability to navigate different track options and tight turns, rewarding brilliance and a shorter path.

Soundness Test:

After completing the Handy round, horses must trot a circle on a loose rein as a final check for soundness, according to USHJA.

FALL FINALE RULES

1. Open to exhibitors from NJ, NY, & PA.
2. NO MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED
3. Entries close Wednesday SEPTEMBER 30th, 2026.
4. Entry fee is \$200.00 per division, no individual classes may be entered, except the NEW DERBY classes, SEE SPECS on page 3.
5. Qualifying criteria: you must have earned 2 champions or reserves or a combination of both. The only divisions which require 1 blue ribbon to qualify are the modified rider and the children's equitation.
6. Classes will be limited to 20 riders. all qualifying entries will be processed in the order they are received. A wait list will be started from the order received.
7. Accepted riders will be POSTED ON HORSESHOWING.COM
8. \$50.00 scratch fee will be assessed. No refunds after SEPTEMBER 30, 2026
9. Late charge of \$50.00 after the closing date, 09/30/2026.
10. Entries must be completed, accompanied by payment and signed on line to be processed.
11. Exhibitors must be in proper riding attire & protective head gear.
12. Exhibitors must wear their back number while schooling. (Mini Stirrup).
13. DERBY CLASSES may be entered providing exhibitor is qualified for a Fall Finale division and shows in said division. Derby entry fees are non-refundable.
